Country-Specific Scholarships

- Aga Khan Foundation International Scholarship Programme: Offers scholarships for
 outstanding students from select countries pursuing studies relevant to their home countries'
 development needs. Eligible countries include Bangladesh, India, Pakistan, Afghanistan, and
 several African nations.
- Armenian International Women's Association (AIWA) Scholarship: Provides scholarships to Armenian women studying law, arts, business, health care, or STEM fields.
- <u>Colfuturo Scholarships</u>: Provides funding for Colombian students pursuing master's or PhD programs in health-related fields.



- <u>CONACYT Scholarships</u>: The National Council of Science and Technology (CONACYT) in Mexico offers scholarships for Mexican students pursuing graduate studies abroad. Check their website for specific programs and application periods.
- Education Future International Scholarship: Offers support to Indian students studying abroad
- <u>Iranian Scholarship Foundation</u>: Offers need-based scholarships to undergraduate and graduate students of Iranian descent.
- John Monash Scholarship: Supports Australian students pursuing postgraduate studies worldwide
- **K.C. Mahindra Education Trust:** Provides interest-free loans to Indian students for postgraduate studies abroad.
- Korean American Scholarship Foundation: Provides scholarships to Korean and Korean American students.
- Margaret McNamara Educational Grants (MMEG): Offers grants to women from developing countries studying at universities in the U.S. or Canada. The program focuses on supporting women who intend to improve lives in their home countries.
- Parker B. Francis Fellowship Program: Supports Canadian scientists in pulmonary, critical care, and sleep medicine research.
- Royal Thai Government Scholarship: Supports Thai students in bachelor's, master's, or PhD programs abroad.
- Rosztoczy Foundation Hungarian Scholarship: Assists Hungarian students and scientists in pursuing studies in the U.S. for up to one year.

Foreign Fulbright Student Programs

The Fulbright Program offers international students opportunities to study, conduct research, and teach in the United States. Eligibility criteria and application processes vary by country. Here are some examples:

- <u>Fulbright-Nehru Fellowships</u>: Provides opportunities for the most outstanding students, academics, and professionals from India to study and conduct research in the United States.
- <u>Fulbright Canada</u>: Enables outstanding Canadian students to study or conduct research in the United States.
- <u>UK Fulbright Commission</u>: Offers various awards for UK students to pursue studies, research, or teaching assistantships in the US.

Other Fellowship Programs

- **AAUW International Fellowships:** Awarded for full-time study or research in the United States to women who are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents.
- **Graduate Women International:** Offers a range of fellowships and grants to support women in their postgraduate studies.
- Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program: A Fulbright program that brings accomplished mid-career professionals from designated countries to the U.S. for non-degree graduate-level study and related professional experiences.
- <u>IIE-Scholar Rescue Fund Fellowship:</u> Provides fellowships for threatened and displaced scholars to continue their work in safety at partnering academic institutions worldwide.
