

1) To a candidate for an internship at the University of Utah and their home institution:

The student intern category of the J-1 visa requires that an intern's <u>home</u> institution (where they are a degree-seeking student) write a **recommendation letter** for the internship. The letter must be dated, signed by a university official, printed on university letterhead, and include the items <u>listed below</u>:

1.	The student is currently enrolled in and pursuing a degree at University (which should be an accredited postsecondary academic institution outside the USA).
2.	The internship will fulfill an educational objective of his/her current degree program at University.
3.	The student is currently in good academic standing at University.
4.	The student will return to his/her academic program to fulfill and obtain a degree from University after completion of the student internship in the USA.
5.	The student will be engaged in a student internship program rather than engaging in employment or providing services to an employer.
6.	Include this statement if true, "The student has sufficient proficiency in the English language to successfully participate in the internship environment, and to successfully function on a day-to-day basis in the USA".
7.	(optional, not required) The student has sufficient funding to support themselves and their dependents (if applicable) for the entire duration of stay in the USA, including housing and living expenses. (this can be a scholarship, grant, personal funds, or compensation from the University of Utah).
2)	To the University of Utah host department - please include this letter, which can be a scanned copy, as part of an application for a DS-2019.
